- Recap from charter school admin meetings instruction continuing online till end of school calendar
- When to finish school? May 22nd last day of school followed by 2 weeks of teachers workdays

ACTION: Paul Fox moves to approve the last day of school for May 22nd, followed by 2 weeks of teacher workdays as proposed by Natalie. We will adjust if needed once we receive further info from state BOE (April F seconded) - MOTION CARRIED 6-0

- Grant that Natalie applied for will probably hear back in July
 - If funded, K-2 teachers would be invited back for an extra 1-2 weeks of paid professional development
- \$4300 received for COVID-related expenses for education (bought things to facilitate remote teaching)

- Should received about \$18,000 additional title 1 funding for next year
- Need to approve contract for Acadia next year

- Discussed process for approving staff contracts for next year with a focus on school charter & values
 - Would be approving at next meeting
- Discussed leaders building leaders program that Natalie is participating in for PD will approve at next Board meeting
